

Write your own Christmas quiz!

Challenge your friends and family over the holidays by creating your own Christmas quiz!




To start off, write a list of categories for each round of your quiz. They could be based on general themes such as books and music, your local area, you could have a picture round or ask people to submit the best Christmas joke.




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Write a few questions based on the themes you've listed above. For example, if one of your themes is animals, you could ask: how many birds are in The 12 Days of Christmas song? If you want your quiz to be a short and snappy one, you can write two or three questions for each, but if you'd like your quiz to last an hour or so, then 5-10 questions per theme is ideal. You may need an extra piece of paper for this.
