The Eggciting Easter Adventure

Note to parents/carers:

Bring the excitement of an Easter Egg hunt to your home using this Story Quest adventure.

You will need:

- This *Eggciting Easter Adventure* booklet
- Four eggs (chocolate, real, plastic or paper!)
- Pen/pencil and paper

How it works:

- Hide the eggs in advance (see below for exact locations)
- Keep your booklets with you so you can read through each clue. You can either print this off or use your phone/tablet
- There is a clue to guide children to each room, followed by a riddle to help them find where the eggs are hidden
- Some clues may require the use of a pen/pencil and paper to solve

Ideas for hiding-places:

- Kitchen - fridge
- Bathroom - bath, shower or sink
- Bedroom - under the pillow!
- Living-room - on the sofa

Bunny command	Action	Completed?
Jumping bunny	Jump as high as you possibly can, as fast as you possibly can.	
Runner bunny	Run on the spot keeping your knees up high.	
Hopping bunny	Bunny hop around the room, wiggling your nose.	
Broad bunny	Jump in a star shape making yourself as wide as possible each time.	
Jelly bunny	Lay on floor, on your belly and wiggle like jelly.	
Chilly bunny	Shiver and shake like a cold bunny.	
Full of bunnies	Dance around the room - REALLY energetically!	
Laughing bunnies	Roll around the room laughing!	
Spring bunnies	Start in crouching position and then spring up suddenly towards the sky, and repeat.	
Super bunnies	Turn into a superhero and zoom around the room.

Here are some fun activities to try at home.

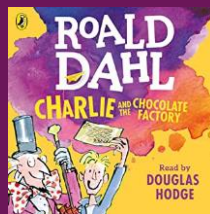
1. Write an Easter riddle!
