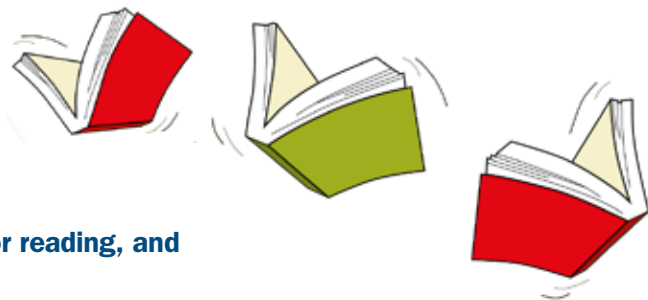
Look out for Dennis, Gnasher and the rest of the gang making their way to Manchester Libraries for this year's Summer Reading Challenge – Mischief Makers.

You can read whatever kinds of books you like – you don't have to stick to a list or read what the teacher tells you! Feeling creative or imaginative? Visit us and get involved with our fun activities and show off the hidden crafter inside you! *Ages 4 and above.*

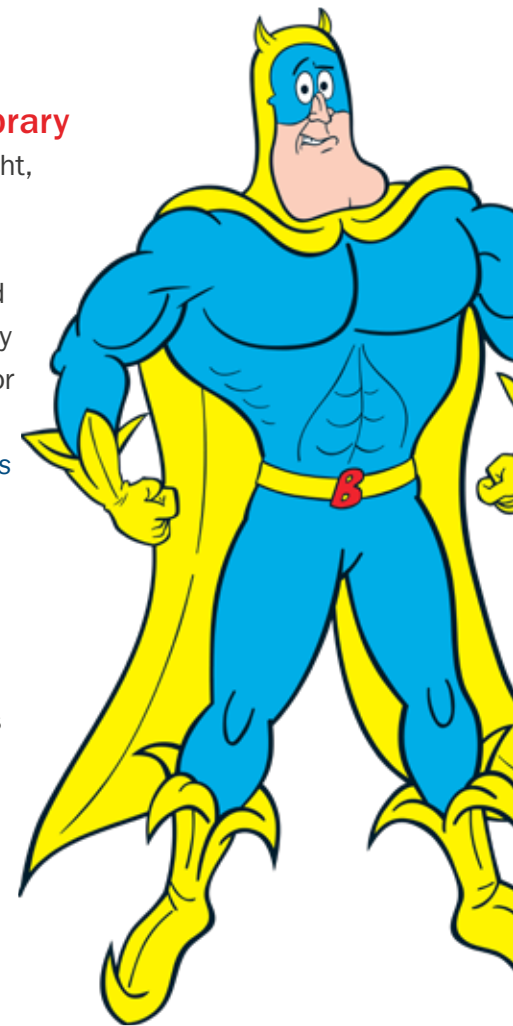
