Recipe

Play dough is great for making beanstalks. You can buy some or make your own at home.

Here's a recipe to make your own:

"Squishing, rolling and flattening play dough helps your child develop muscles in their hands. It's useful for learning to hold a pencil or using scissors."



- 4 tablespoons plain flour
- 2 tablespoons salt
- ½ cup warm water
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 4 5 drops green food colouring
- 1 tablespoon of split peas

Mix the ingredients all together in a bowl. The more food colouring you add, the darker your green will be.
