Chocolate Challenge

Make your own playdough

- 2 cups flour
- 1/2 cup of table salt
- 1 1/2 cups of boiling water (you need an adult for this bit)
- 2 tablespoons of cooking oil
- *1/2 cup of cocoa/hot chocolate powder or food colouring (*optional)

Mix it together then knead until soft and stretchy

Can you make your own sweets using dough or card?
 Can you make 10 sweets?
 Can you think of a new name for your sweets which starts with the same letter as your name?

Top tip
 You could cut out your new sweets from a cereal box. You could stick things on or use pens or pencils to decorate them. 👍
