Talking point list: Things you need to be a good reader



You have to understand lots of different words

You have to be able to create pictures in your head and have a good imagination

You have to read lots of different sorts of reading material

You need to be a good thinker

You need to be able to spot information quickly

You need to use the information and experience you already have

You should be good at phonics

You must like reading

You have to be good at talking about books

You have to be able to read quickly

You need to understand every single word

You need to read things that you don't enjoy

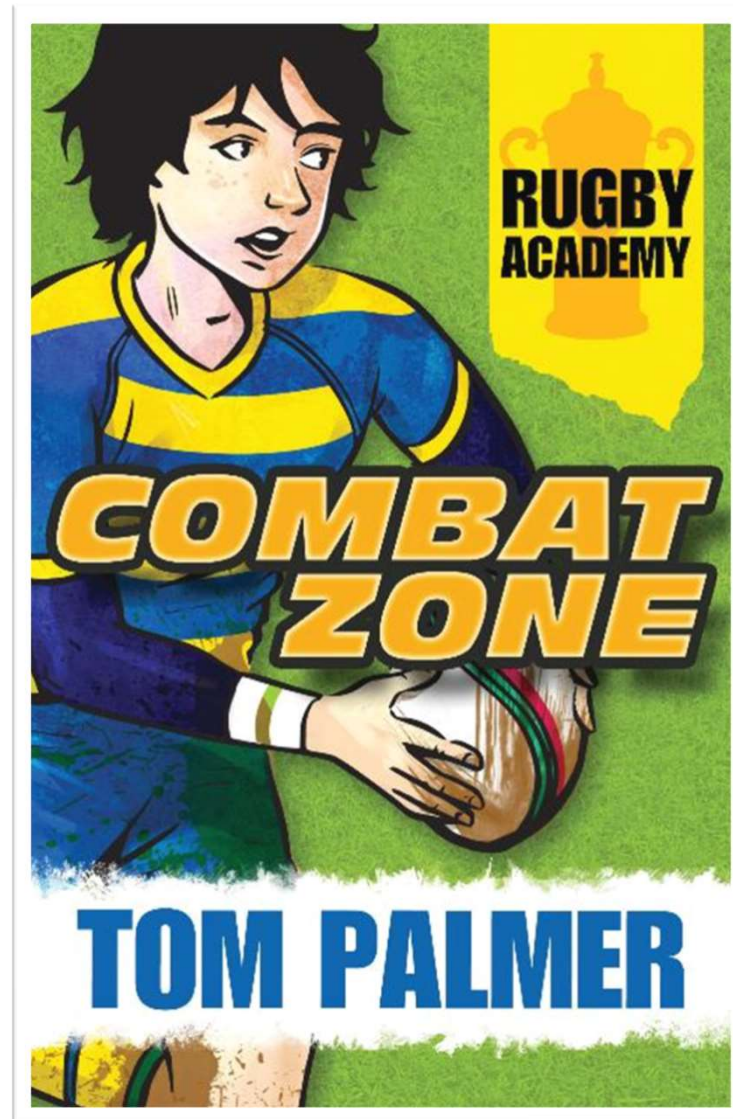

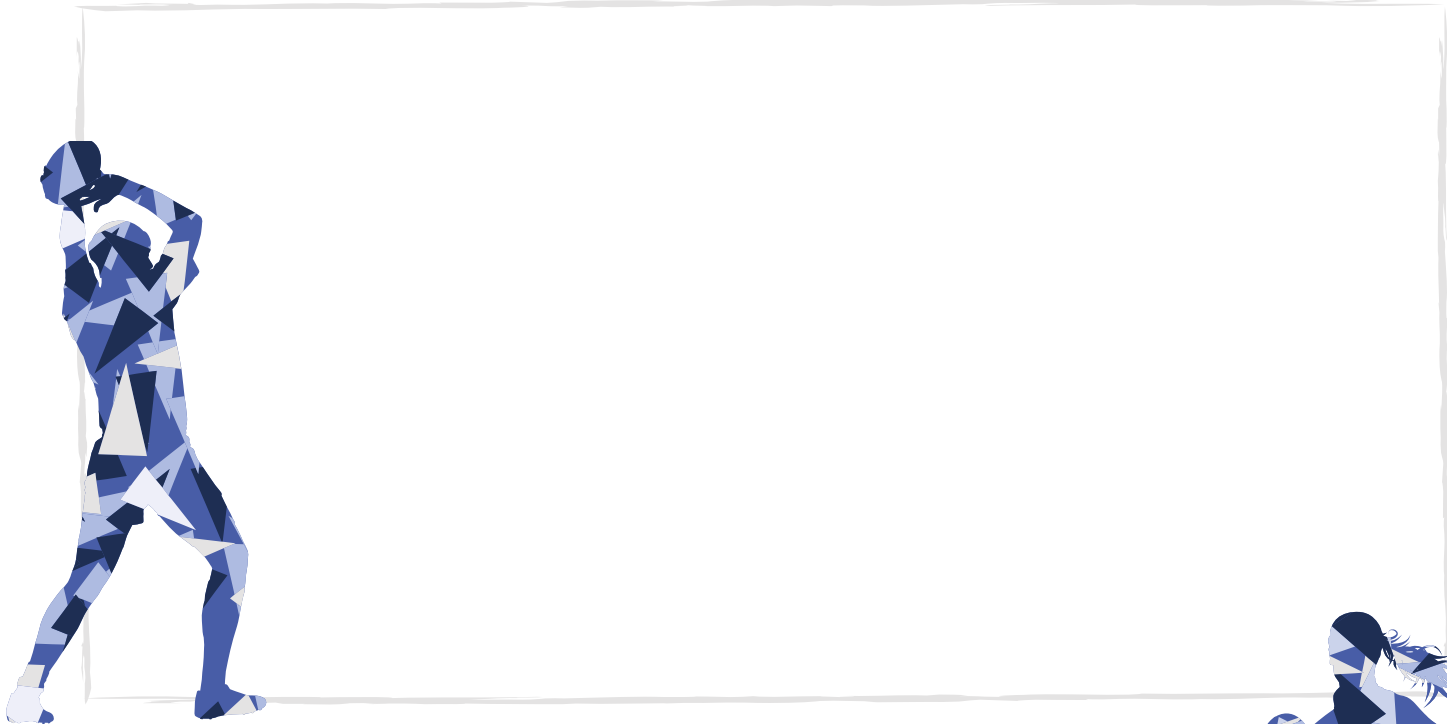


