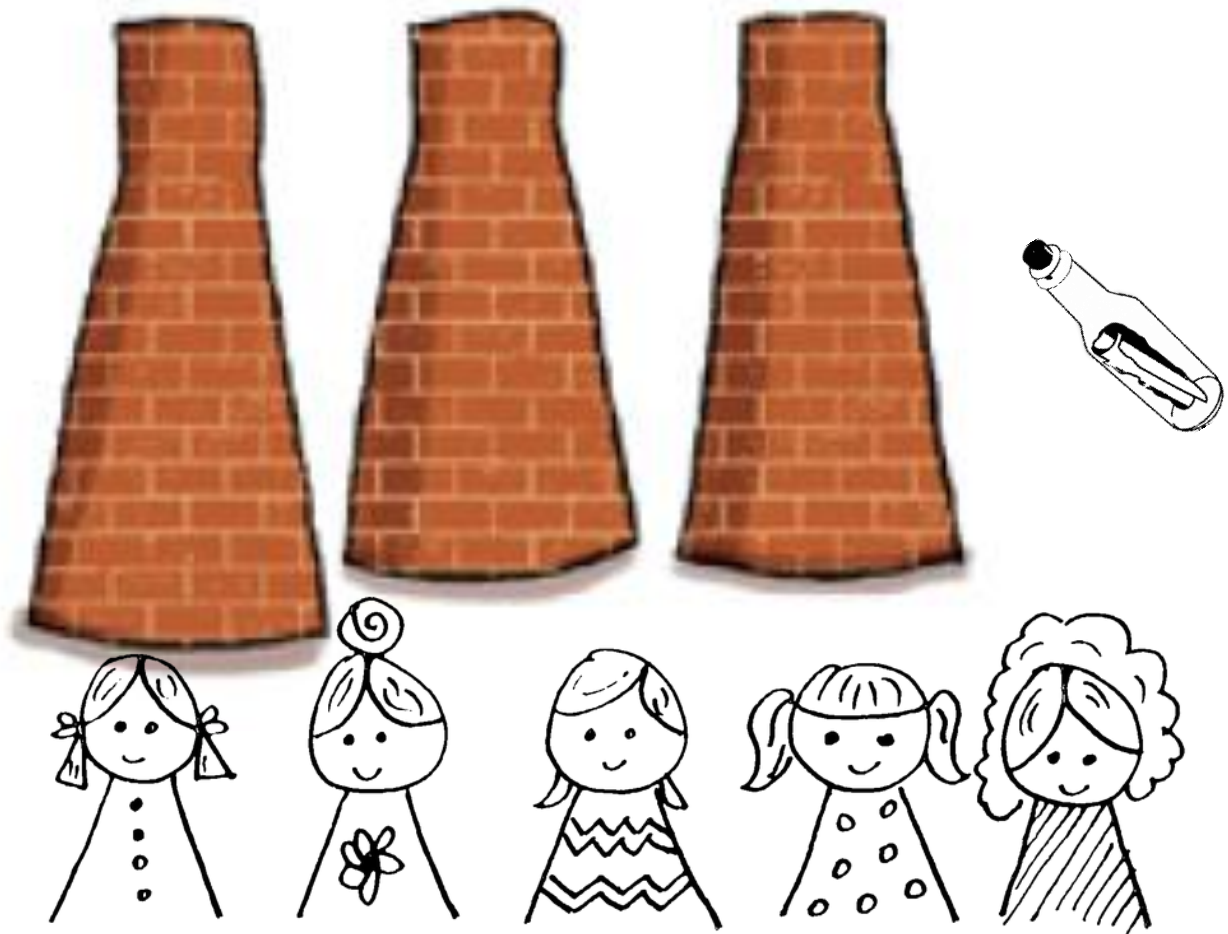

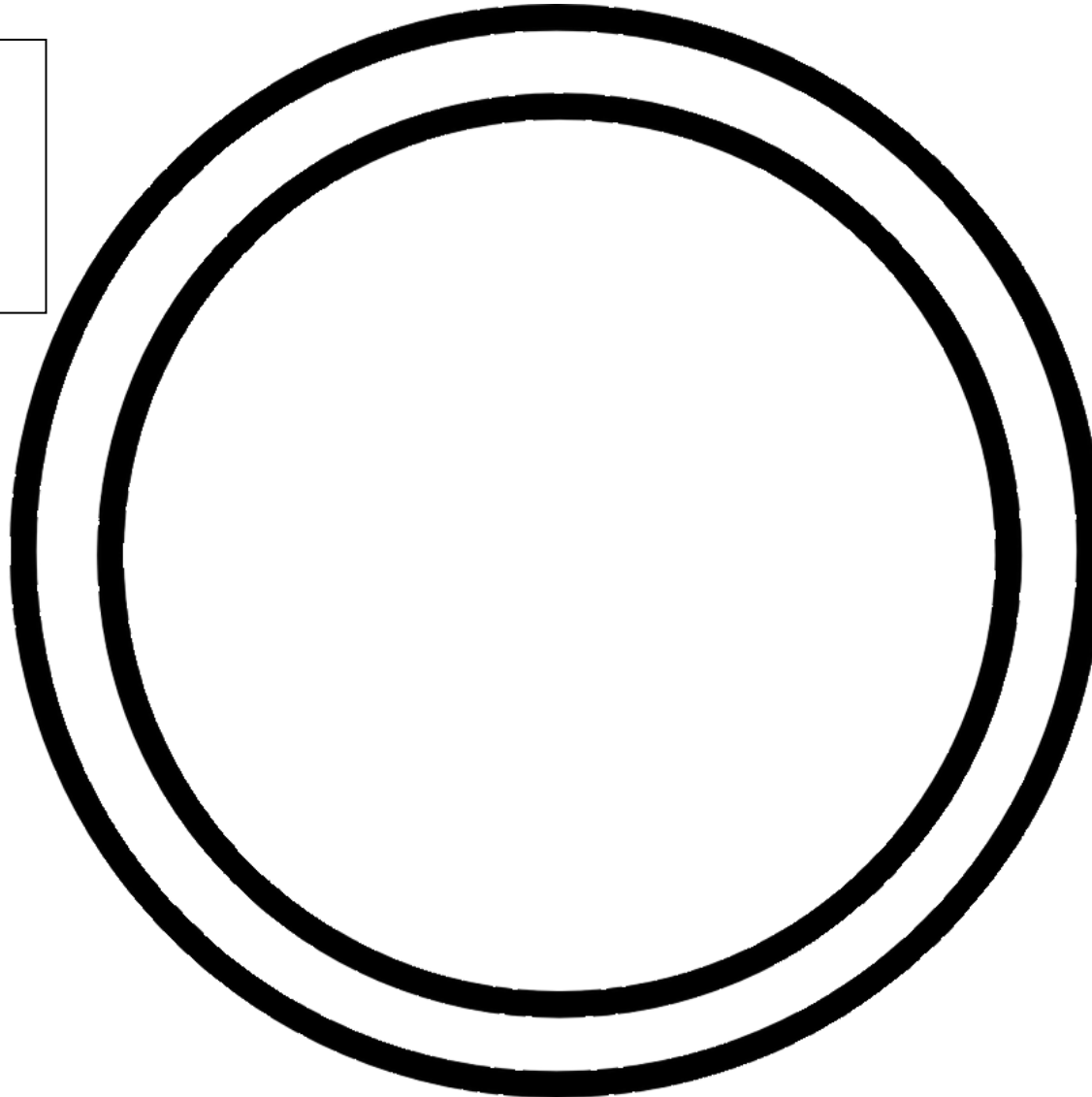
Willow Pattern Plate

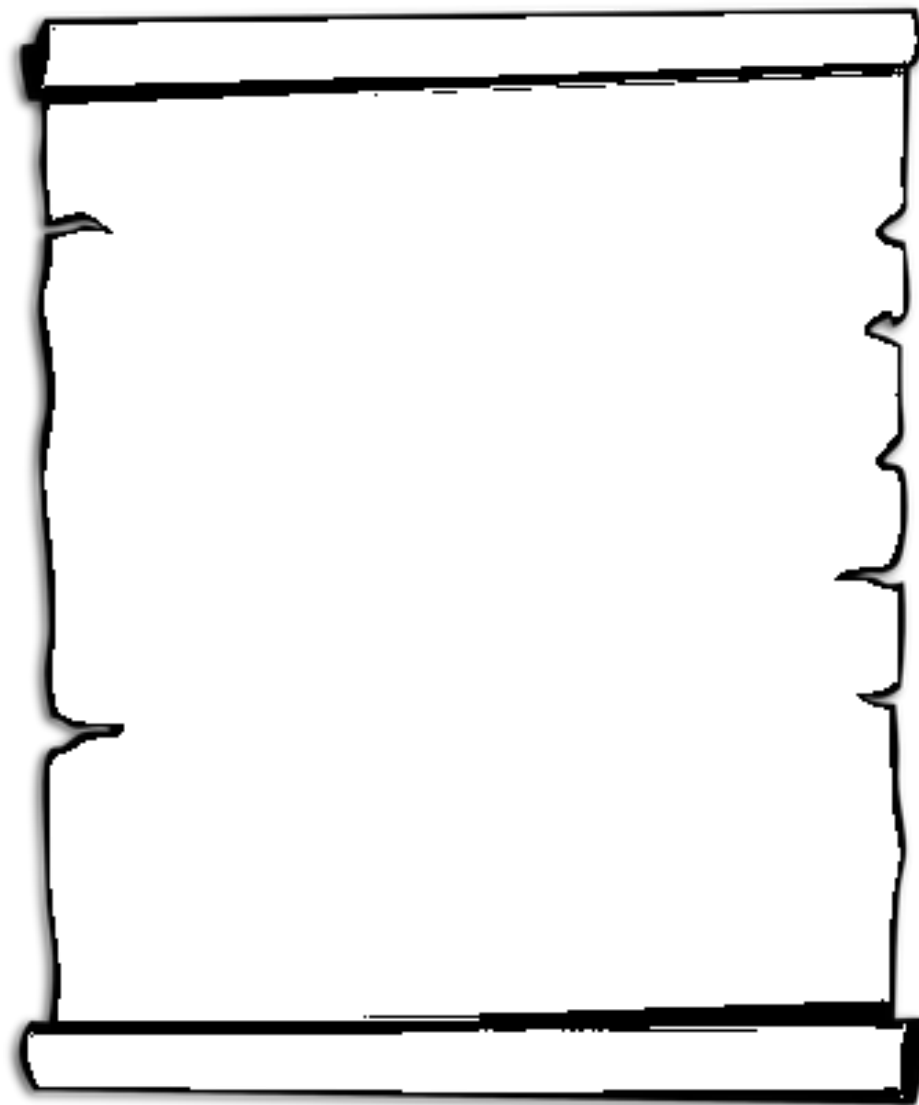
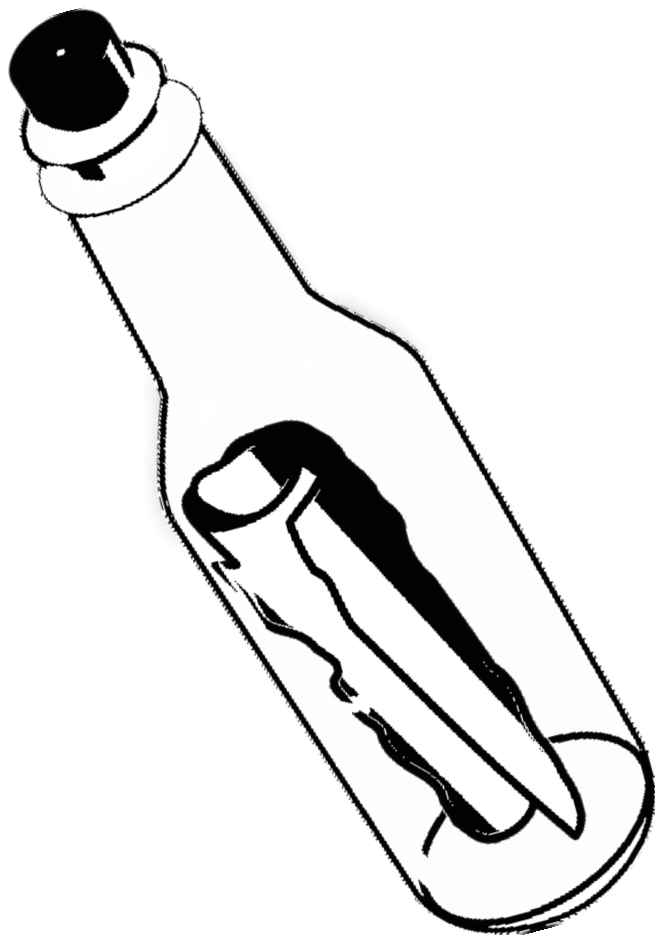
