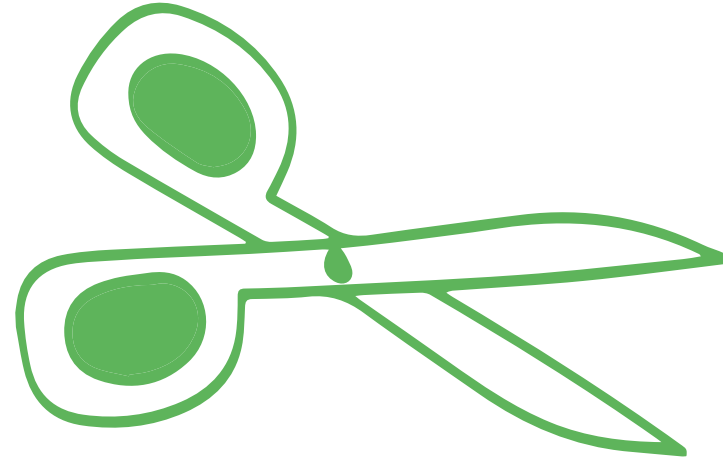
You might like to make a pair of binoculars for your adventure - an explorer must always keep on the lookout!

You will need

- Two empty toilet rolls
- Sticky tape or glue
- Scissors
- String or shoe laces

Optional for decorating

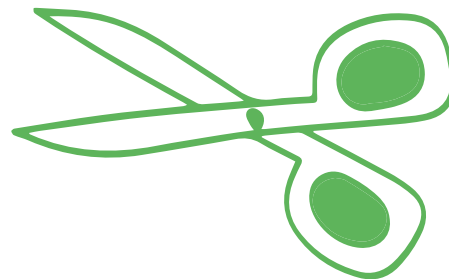
- Stickers
- Coloured pens or pencils



Method

- 1. Stick the toilet rolls together**
- 2. Measure and cut your string so it is long enough to wear around your neck**
- 3. Help your child cut a small hole on the top outside edge of both toilet rolls**
- 4. Take one end of your string and thread it through the hole you made**
- 5. Tie a knot to secure and repeat with the other side of the string**
- 6. Colour in or use stickers to decorate your binoculars**
